POTPOURRI

The results of ISC and ICSE declared by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), New Delhi on May 7, 2019 have once again proved the supremacy of Nabhaites in academics. While the Batch average for ISC is a whopping 88.4%, for ICSE the Batch average is 84.2%. In ISC (Science Stream), Arshdeep Singh topped with 95.50% marks. In ISC (Commerce), Jasmohit Kaur shone with 94.50% marks. In ISC (Humanities), Kunwar Inayat was first with 96.25% marks. In ICSE, Harmanjot Singh Kohli peaked with 97% marks. Out of 76 students who appeared for ISC, 75 passed with Distinction with 1 First Division. Out of 139 students who appeared for ICSE, 121 passed with Distinction with 18 First Divisions. Moreover, 48 students made a Perfect Score of 100 in different subjects.

Secondly, the school is gearing up for the Diamond Jubilee Founders' Day on April 11, 2020. A number of activities are being taken up in the run-up to the final event. The students, especially, are in an upbeat mood to ensure that everything happens perfectly. The excitement, jubilation and celebration are in the air. It is bound to be given the legacy of the school over the last six decades. The year-long celebrations started in right earnest with Mr Jai Singh Gill, President, Executive Committee laying the foundation stone for the Cambridge Block on April 1, 2019.

Finally, Dr Jagpreet Singh being conferred **Mahatma Gandhi Leadership Award** on May 20, 2019 in House of Commons, London by NRI Welfare Society of India in association with Indian Solidarity Council and The Punjab Public School being recognised as a **High Performing School of 2018** in India in February by the **AKS Education Awards** is a matter of pride for the entire PPS fraternity. It may be recalled the school was recognised as one of the **Top Future 50 Schools Shaping Success (Residential Schools)** in November. Future 50 Schools Shaping Success is a premium annual evaluation of progressive schools across India conceptualised by industry powerhouses Univariety (Education Partner), Fortune India (Media Partner) and PwC (Process Advisers). The school was also conferred the **International School Award (ISA)** by the British Council for the fourth time in December 2018. These accolades and recognitions demand more concerted efforts to maintain the heights attained and go still higher.

From the Headmaster's Desk



Passing Out Ceremony-2019

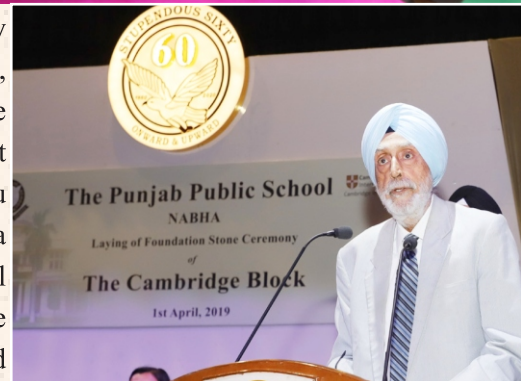

(Rugby School, Rugby, England)

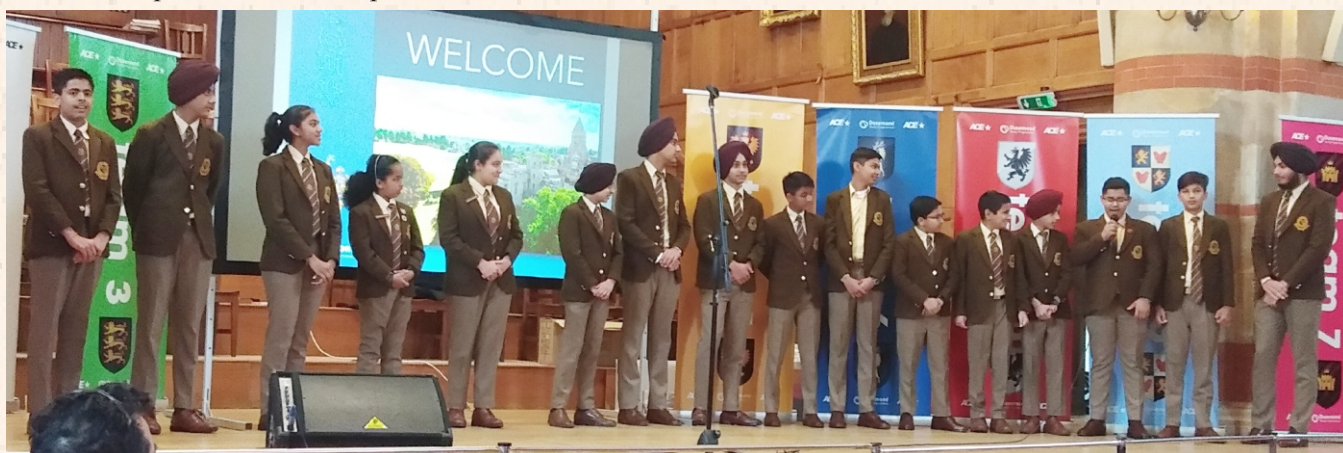
