(*Example: "The Lotus stands for purity."*)

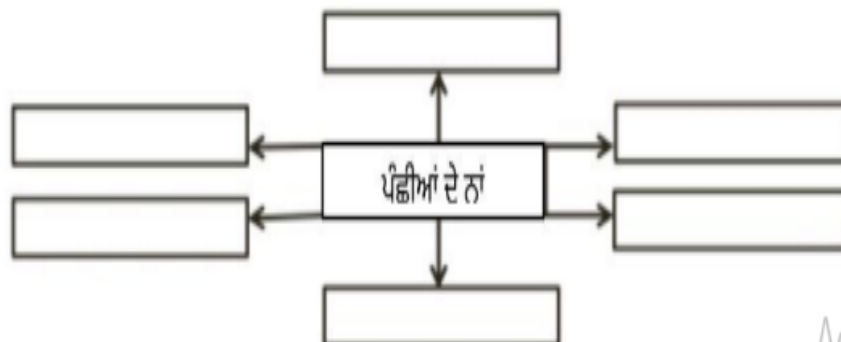
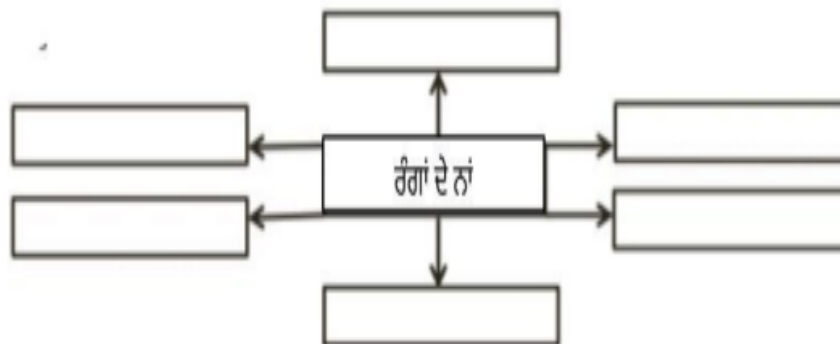
- **Project work:** -Go through the list of Presidents of India with their terms in office.
